* The "Team Managers' Meeting" will take place on Friday, June 30th, 2023 at 06:00pm and is mandatory for all team managers.

General Regulations

- The regatta will take place on the **regatta course Vienna – New Danube/Steinspörnbrücke** according to the regulations of the RoR of FISA supplemented by the RWB of the ÖRV. The course has **6 lanes and is equipped with Albano system and traffic light start system**.
- The start for **2000m races** will be from the **starting bridge** with traffic light start, for **all other race** distances **flying start**.
- The boat classes and the order of the races are shown in the race program on page 2.
- **Age Categories**

SchM-B/SchW-B	= Under 13	2011 or younger
SchM/SchW	= Under 15	2009/2010
JM-B/JW-B	= Under 17	2007/2008
JM-A/JW-A	= Under 19	2005/2006
M/W	= Men and Women	2004 and older
- **Junior rowers:** must be swimming competent and insured. All Austrian juniors - also U13/U15 - who start are only allowed to start with a valid junior license. The junior licenses of the registered rowers must be available to the secretariat of the ÖRV at the latest by the registration deadline of the regatta. If the license of a rower is not available at the time of the registration deadline, the rower loses his (her) eligibility to start. The entry is invalid.
- **Lightweights:** Lightweight rowers will start in the respective open boat classes as shown on page 2 and will be scored separately.
 - A female single sculler may not weigh more than 59 kg (junior 57.5 kg).
 - A male single sculler may not weigh more than 72.5 kg (junior 67.5kg).
 - The weighing of the light weights will take place two to max. one hour before the first race of the team on each regatta day in the marked room.
- **Coxswains:** The minimum weight of the coxswains results from the RWB. The coxswains will be weighed in race uniform at the earliest two and at the latest one hour before the first race in which they participate on each regatta day. For necessary weights, which are not brought along, a deposit of 20 Euro is to be deposited.

Progression System

- All races will take place on a **maximum of 6 starting lanes**.
- The races of all boat classes **on Saturday are Heats** and count as **qualification for the final races on Sunday**. If there are less than 7 boats entered in a class, the Saturday race will be held as a race for lanes.
- If there are **more than 18 entries** for a race, the **heats will be held as a time trial**. Alternate starts on 2 lanes at 30 second intervals.
- The **progression mode** is based on the number of entries per race and is available on the website www.virr.at/information. Those who did not start or finish on Saturday will be placed in the last final on Sunday.
- The organizer reserves the right to seed teams regardless of the preliminary race.

Entries and entry fees

- Entries are to be made exclusively at <http://regatten.rudern.at/>.
- The entries must contain all information of the prescribed forms.
- **The closing date for entries is Wednesday, June 21th, 2023, at 06:00pm.**
- **Late entries will be accepted until Friday, June 30th, 2023, 06:00pm.**
- Races will be held if at least two boats are registered at the entry deadline.
- The OC is responsible for the decision of the combination of races with single registrations. Late entries will only be accepted for races existing on June, 21th 2023. However, there is no entitlement for acceptance of a late entry. A decision in this regard is at the sole discretion of the OC. Late entries will be classified according to availability. Entry fee for late entries according to RWB with 50% surcharge.
- **Mixed club crews** are allowed, except for the U13 and U15 races.
- The registering club confirms that the registered members agree to the processing of their personal data by the organizer and the ÖRV for the purpose of informing the public about participation and results within the framework of the data protection regulations; this agreement also applies to the publication of photos and film recordings.
- The **entry fees** are to be transferred to the account,

- Cash payments are not possible. If a race is cancelled, the entry fee will be refunded according to RWB §37 (6).
- Entry fees are valid per boat class and boat for the whole race weekend (one price for Saturday and Sunday).

- **Foreign clubs** pay **50% of the entry fee** and a **maximum of € 650,00**. **Austrian Clubs** pay 100% of the entry fee and a maximum of € 1.000,00.
- With the entry a **team manager incl. phone number** has to be announced to office@virr.at. The team manager agrees to receive information about the regatta via Whatsapp group.

Para-Rowing

- **PR1 and PR3** follow the international classification guidelines, but a start is also possible for rowers without an official classification.
- **Inclusion boats:** must be seated by at least one para-rower.
- **Mixed classes:** Teams must consist of both male and female athletes.

Empacher-Youthcup 2023

The club with the youth team with the most overall points according to the criteria below will be awarded. The scoring results from the 33 races marked with "*" (all U13, U15, U17, U19 races, see table on page 2).

The points classification is composed of start points and performance points:

- **Start points:** for each athlete competing in a final race the club receives 1 point (incl. coxswains).
- **Performance points:** see table below

** The number is determined by the number of boats starting in one boat class over all finals on Sunday.

Mixed Club Crews: Each club within the Crew receives the number of starting points of the starting athletes belonging to the club (incl. coxswains) and the full number of performance points of the won placing (see table; e.g. Performance points: Mixed Crew AB wins a race with 6 starting boats and is composed of athletes from club A and club B: both club A and club B receive 6 points). If a racing group is registered as an association, this association receives the points, the decisive factor is the registered team name. Mixed Crews in U13 and U15 are not allowed.

Note: Points will only be awarded if the team competes in both the preliminary race / heat (on Saturday) and the final race (on Sunday).

Prize: The club with the most total points (start and performance points added) will receive the **Empacher Youth Cup** and a **cash prize**. The payment will be made to the authorized entrant or team manager.

Masters

- Entries for Masters races are only valid with indication of the year of birth.
The rowers must be able to prove their age with an official document.
The international age categories A-J are valid.

A- minimum age 27 years	B- average age 36 years
C- average age 43 years	D- average age 50 years
E- average age 55 years	F- average age 60 years
G- average age 65 years	H- average age 70 years
I- average age 75 years	J- average age 80 years

- The race will be held with at least two teams from two clubs (no matter if they belong to the same age category (e.g. A+A; then no handicap will be used) or if they belong to two different but not more than 3 adjacent handicap age categories (e.g. A+B or B+C; then the handicap according to the table below will be used at the start)).
- Handicap table (time advantage in seconds for the 1000 m distance); The time differences given apply only to adjacent age categories for races over 1,000 meters.

- The umpires will announce at the start if the start will be with a handicap depending on the wind conditions or if the handicap will be settled at the finish.
- If the starter decides on false start, the starting procedure will not be stopped. The guilty team receives a time penalty of ten seconds.

Miscellaneous

- Big Blades** are not allowed in U13 and U15 races.
- The **winning teams** of all final races on Sunday will receive **prizes**.
 - In **races with more than 3 starting final boats**: Place 1-3 will receive medals.
 - In **races with 3 or less starting final boats**: 1st place will receive a medal.
 - In **combined races**: the above two points are valid for each starting category. There will be one award ceremony per category after the finish of the best placed boat in each category.
 - In **Master races**: Exclusively 1st place in each age category will receive a medal, regardless of whether the age categories are raced together or separated.
- The **storage of the boats** and the **parking** of the boat transport trolleys are exclusively at your own risk. The organizer does not assume any liability.
- For the **access to the regatta area with boat trailers and/or crew buses** an entry permit is available against a deposit of € 20,00.
- The **COVID preventive measures** are based on the legal requirements valid for the regatta weekend and will be strictly observed.
- Liability**: The organizer is liable according to the provisions of Austrian statutory law. The insurance of material and persons is a matter of the participants. The organizer does not assume any liability for damages of any kind.
